REGULATION No. 70 OF 29 MAY 2006 SETTING OUT REQUIREMENTS AS TO THE LABEL OR OTHER DOCUMENT MADE OUT BY THE PRODUCER OF ORNAMENTAL PLANT PROPAGATING MATERIAL

Effective date 1 January 2007

Issued by the Minister of Agriculture and Forestry

Promulgated, SG No. 46 of 6 June 2006

- **Article 1.** This Regulation shall introduce the requirements to the label or other document made out by the producer of ornamental plant propagating material, including ornamental plant seed in accordance with Article 8 of Council Directive 98/56/EC transposed with Regulation No. 16 of 2004 on the production and marketing of ornamental plant seed and propagating material (SG, No. 51/2004).
- **Article 2.** (1) The label or other document referred to in Article 1 shall be made out of an appropriate material which has not been used yet and it shall be printed in the Bulgarian language and/or an official language of the European Union (EU) with the following particulars:
- 1. indication 'EC quality';
- 2. code of the Republic of Bulgaria; code of the EU Member State in the case of imports;
- 3. indication or distinguishing code of the IASAS; designation or distinguishing code of the official body in the case of imports;
- 4. registration number of the producer;
- 5. individual production, week or lot number;
- 6. botanical name of the species;
- 7. denomination of the variety in the cases of marketing as a variety; name of the variety or its designation in the case of marketing of rootstocks;
- 8. denomination of the group of plants;
- 9. quantity;
- 10. in the case of imports from third countries the name of the country of production.
- (2) In the case where the propagating material is accompanied by a phytosanitary (plant) passport in accordance with Regulation No. 1 of 1998 on phytosanitary control (SG, No. 82/1998), the following particulars may be added to the label referred to in paragraph 1: indication or distinguishing code of the NPPS, the number of the phytosanitary passport, and the registration number of the producer in accordance with Regulation No. 1 on phytosanitary control.
- (3) In the case where the propagating material is accompanied by a phytosanitary (plant) passport in accordance with Commission Directive 92/105/EEC as transposed with Regulation No. 1 of 1998 on phytosanitary control, the phytosanitary passport may constitute the document referred to in paragraph 1 with the following additional particulars:
- 1. indication 'EC quality';
- 2. indication or distinguishing code of the IASAS; designation or distinguishing code of the official body in the case of imports;
- 3. denomination of the variety, rootstock or group of plants.
- (4) In the case of imports from third countries under paragraph 3, the name of the country of production shall also be indicated.
- (5) The particulars referred to in paragraphs 3 and 4 may be included in the phytosanitary passport if clearly delineated.

SUPPLEMENTARY PROVISIONS

§ 1. For the purposes of this Regulation, 'rootstock' means a part of an ornamental plant as a propagating material, which is intended for growth of its underground part.

§ 2. This Regulation transposes Commission Directive 1999/66/EC of 28 June 1999 setting out requirements as to the label or other document made out by the supplier pursuant to Council Directive 98/56/EC.

FINAL PROVISIONS

- § 3. This Regulation is issued pursuant to Article 29(6) of the Seed and Propagating Material Act.
- § 4. This Regulation shall enter into force on 1 January 2007.
